- the concentration (percentage by weight) in which these substances are contained in products or product packaging,
- where applicable, the ECHA SCIP number, 2018/851/EU

As long as you do not send us updated information starting with the first delivery or subsequent deliveries, no corresponding or updated information, we assume that these are not contained in your products or product packaging at present and in the future. You will be contacted by us on an annual basis.

We would like to expressly point out to you that we will pass on to you all claims of third parties which are lawfully asserted against HellermannTyton GmbH & Co. KG due to your non-compliance with the aforementioned statutory provisions.
