

Conflict Minerals Information:

Dear Conflict Minerals Team,

Attached is the final 2018 Aptiv PLC conflict minerals reporting template (CMRT) v5.11, dated January 25, 2019. Aptiv's company level CMRT, covers all Aptiv sites. If you prefer to receive data through iPoint, please send a request to iPoint id 2693.

Aptiv does not track material usage in a manner that allows us to respond at an individual product level for any of its products, customers, or sites. Aptiv's "company level" CMRT is applicable to all products sold by Aptiv.

The response from our suppliers account for nearly 97% of our relevant spend. Although we did not have a 100% supplier response rate, we believe that the 316 identified smelters represent all the likely smelters in our supply chain. We conducted extended due diligence on several smelters and, while not being able to remove them from our probable supply chain, we found no evidence indicating that they currently benefit or finance armed groups in the DRC.

Understanding that JSC Ekaterinburg and Safina A.S. were included in the sanctions by the US government as of April 2018 (with a wind down window of June 2018). Aptiv communicated to our relevant supply base that we would not accept product that contains raw materials sourced from JSC Ekaterinburg and Safina A.S. after June 5, 2018.

To the best of our knowledge, suppliers are taking steps to comply with the sanctions. The majority of the suppliers providing the sanctioned smelters to Aptiv are non-US entities shipping from outside the U.S.
