Dear Valued Customer,

HellermannTyton's conflict minerals reporting is included within the reporting of our parent Company, Aptiv. Aptiv's former name was Delphi Automotive LLP. Aptiv's 2018 conflict minerals reporting template (CMRT), dated September 7 2018 is attached. Aptiv's **company level** CMRT, covers all Aptiv sites, including HellermannTyton. If you prefer to receive data through iPoint, please send a request to **iPoint id 2693**.

Aptiv will continue to evaluate, follow-up and compile our supplier responses throughout the remainder of this reporting year. An updated 2018 CMRT will be sent to you by end of November, 2018 and Aptiv's final year-end CMRT will be sent by end of January, 2019. At which time, you will see an increased supplier response rate, additional information and Aptiv's final smelter list.

Please note, Aptiv does not track material usage in a manner that allows us to respond at an individual product level for any of its products, customers, or sites. Aptiv's "company level" response is applicable to all products sold by Aptiv owned companies.

Understanding that JSC Ekaterinburg and Safina A.S. smelters are currently subject to sanctions by the US government as of action in April 2018. Aptiv confirms that we communicated to our relevant supply base that we will not accept product that contains raw materials sourced from these smelters after June 5, 2018. We appreciate your understanding and patience as we work with our suppliers to confirm that JSC Ekaterinburg and Safina A.S. smelters have been removed from the supply chain.
